


1 About Canada

Canada is a highly developed trillion-dollar economy. It is the second largest country in the world by landmass, with six time zones, ten provinces and three territories. It is the 9th largest country in the world in terms of GDP¹. The country has three main economic centers: Western Canada (Vancouver, Edmonton and Calgary), Ontario and Quebec. The official languages of Canada are English and French².

Canada is greatly dependent on international trade, which makes up about one-third of its GDP. The country offers excellent trade and investment opportunities for exporters and Indian global companies across several sectors.

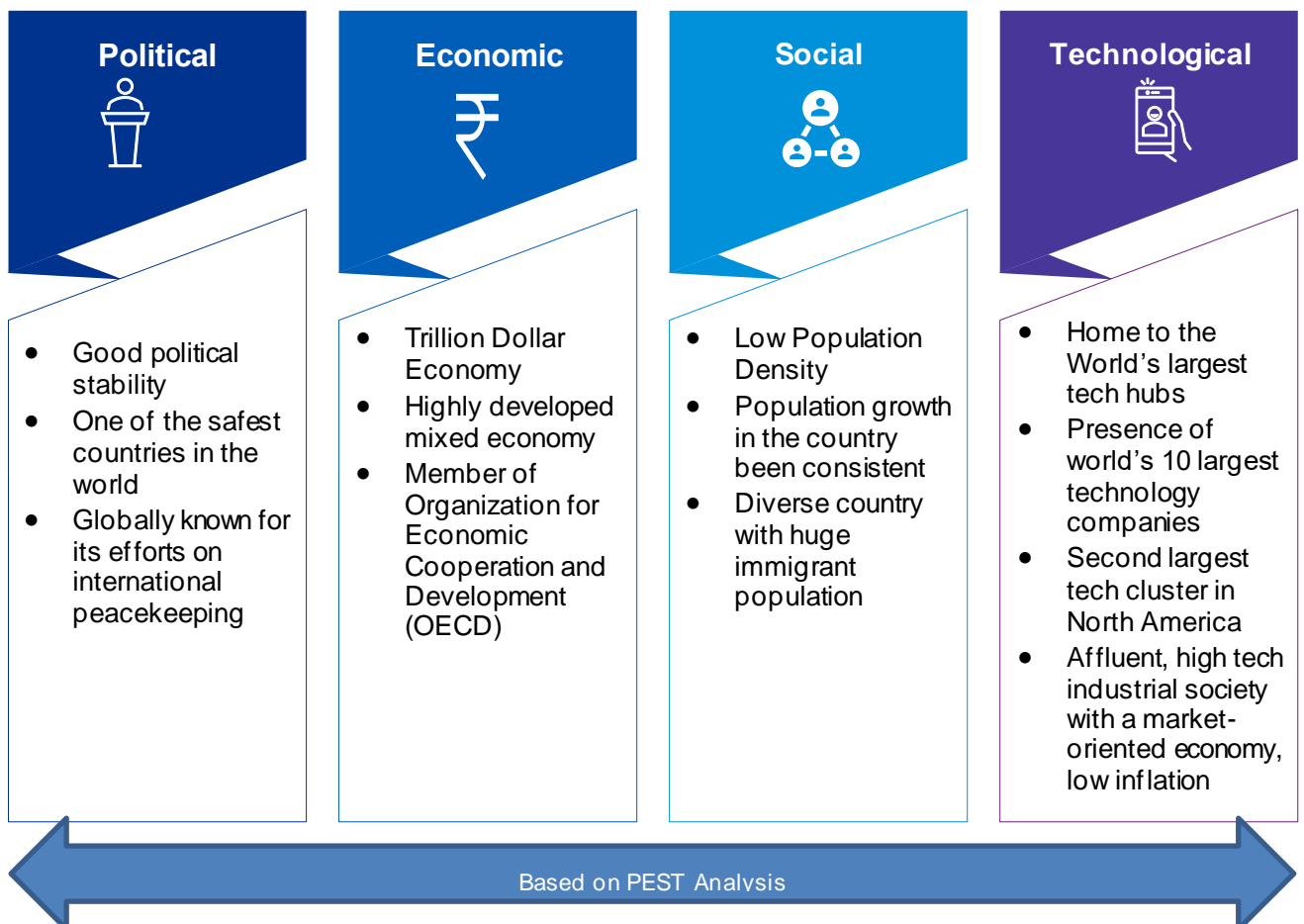

Macro-Economic Environment of Canada





India-Canada shares strong bilateral ties in terms of economic engagement, high level interactions and presence of huge Indian diaspora. Both sides pursue bilateral relations through various dialogue mechanisms such as Ministerial level - Strategic, Trade and Energy Dialogues, Foreign Office Consultations, and other sector specific Joint Working Groups (JWG).

Canada hosts one of the largest Indian diasporas in the world, numbering 1.6 million which account for more than 3% of its total population.

India is Canada’s 14th largest trading partner. Despite the disruptions during Covid-19, India’s exports to Canada have grown from USD 2594.7 mn.(2016) to USD 3460.5 mn. (2020) at a CAGR of 7.5%.

Bilateral Visits

Some of the recent bilateral visits include the following:

- Indian Prime Minister (PM) Modi's visit to Canada in April 2015 elevated the bilateral relation to a strategic partnership.
- Canadian PM Justin Trudeau paid his first State Visit to India from 18 to 24 February 2018
- Canadian Minister of Trade and Export Development, Minister of Immigration and Career Training of Saskatchewan visited India with a trade delegation (18-22 November 2019)
- Canadian Minister for Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade visited India (November 16-23, 2019)
- Minister of Civil Aviation, Government of India visited Montreal from 24 September to 4 October 2019 to attend 40th Session of International Civil Aviation Organization
- External Affairs Minister (EAM), Government of India visited Ottawa on 19-20 December 2019
- Both sides pursue bilateral relations through the dialogue mechanisms such as Ministerial level- Strategic, Trade and Energy dialogues; Foreign Office Consultations; and other sector specific joint working groups (JWG). Since 2019, Joint Working Group (JWG) on Higher Education (26-28 February 2019); 16th JWG on Counter Terrorism (26-27 March 2019); Joint Committee Meeting on Civil Nuclear (6-7 June 2019); and Inaugural edition of Consular Dialogue with Canada (30 September -1 October 2019) have been held



During 2016 to 2019, Karnataka’s exports to Canada increased from USD 174.2 mn. to USD 236.3 mn. In 2020, Karnataka’s exports declined to USD 120.5 mn attributed to the disruptions caused due to Covid-19. Karnataka’s Top 10 Exports products to Canada are given in the table below. The State’s Top 10 products contribute to 84% in its total exports to Canada.

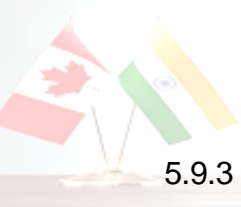

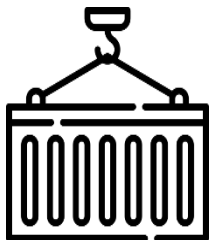
